Champions of Business Growth Drive Results for Greater Rochester, NY Region

Greater Rochester Enterprise (GRE), the lead economic development organization in the Greater Rochester, NY region, secured 37 separate company project wins in 2023, representing more than \$1.5 billion of new capital investments, the creation of 1,547 new jobs, and the retention of 2,533 jobs. GRE's 2023 results represent a strong level of success across key performance metrics that illustrate the organization's positive impact on business growth throughout the nine-county region.

As a trusted advisor, GRE connects business executives with the right people and the right resources including real estate, research and development assets, local supply chain and business partners, international trade assistance, economic development incentives, recruitment assistance and training funds.

In September, GRE received a 2023 Gold Award of Excellence from the International Economic Development Council (IEDC) in the Business Retention and Expansion Initiatives category for the GRE Economic Gardening program. Among 580 award submissions, GRE's program was also noted as a Best in Show nominee. This recognition from IEDC underscores the exceptional work GRE delivers to the Greater Rochester, NY region's businesses.



GRE Has Proven Track Record of Success

GRE reports an increase in several key performance indicators versus the prior year and five-year historical data. A total of \$1.5 billion of new capital investments in 2023 is an **increase of 25%** versus 2022, GRE's previous record high year. In addition, 2,533 jobs retained in 2023 is **76%** more jobs retained than in 2022. The number of new jobs created was lower than 2022 due to a significant shift to manufacturing automation, which requires fewer jobs. When looking at a five-year trend, GRE recorded an increase of **more than \$1 billion** in new capital investments, **12% increase** in project wins, **33% increase** in new jobs created, and a **92% increase** in total projects under management. These strong performance metrics validate GRE's sustained commitment to support business growth and investment in the Greater Rochester, NY region through enhanced business development strategies, targeted marketing, focused outreach, and relationship building with business leaders and site selectors.

The GRE team has managed hundreds of different business attraction and expansion projects since the organization was established. Game Changing Resources to Grow Your Business

During 2023, GRE managed a portfolio of 296 total projects, representing a wide range of industries in strategic growth sectors that reflect the region's strengths: advanced manufacturing, food and beverage manufacturing, energy innovation, optics, photonics, and imaging and semiconductor. The GRE team secured 37 project wins, approximately 32% were business attraction projects and 68% were business expansion projects from companies already located in the region.

In addition to guiding companies through the economic development process, GRE connects companies to people and resources to spur growth here. The following chart outlines several of these project wins.

Nationally Recognized Model for Business Growth GRE also supports the growth of existing businesses in the region through the GRE Economic Gardening program, a nationally recognized model of success. This unique initiative provides strategic research to privately held companies with 10 to 99 employees and \$1 to \$50 million in revenue. Since 2012, GRE has served more than 270 companies through the program. Collectively, these companies have created 1,860 new jobs and increased revenues by more than \$767 million

since participating in the program. When surveyed, 99% of participants would recommend this program.
